Word	Definition
Christmas	The annual Christian festival celebrating Jesus Christ's birth, held on 25 December.
Nativity	The occasion of a person's birth.
Jesus	The name of the man who Christians believe was the son of God.
God	God, in Christianity, is believed to be the being who created all things.
Unique	Being different from all others.
Precious	Something that is of rare and of great value.
Incarnation	The Christian belief that God took human form by becoming Jesus.
