Word	Definition
Christmas	The annual Christian festival celebrating Jesus Christ's birth, held on 25 December.
Diwali	For the Sikhs, Diwali is a story of the struggle for freedom .
Holi	A Hindu spring festival celebrated in February or March in honour of Krishna
Celebrate	Acknowledge (a significant or happy day or event) with a social gathering or enjoyable activity
Sikhism	A religion founded in Punjab in the 15th century by Guru Nanak.
Hinduism	A major religious and cultural tradition of South Asia, which developed from Vedic religion.
Christianity	The religion based on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ, or its beliefs and practices.
