



Uniform

PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL ITEMS OF SCHOOL WEAR ARE LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME

It is an expectation of attending our school that all children will wear the correct school uniform. Items can be bought from any supplier. Any items you require with a school logo can be purchased from Hucknall Sports at the bottom of the High Street in Hucknall.

Children will need a book bag every day containing their Personal Organiser, reading books and any letters that need to be returned to school.

Children will need a named water bottle that must be taken home every day. Fresh water should be brought into school every day. We ask that you only provide your child with water to encourage your child to be healthy. Children can also bring a healthy fruit snack into school (no nuts).

PE Kit

Children will need to wear their PE kit to school on their allocated PE day and any other day requested.

- White polo shirt
- Pale blue shorts
- Navy blue tracksuit for winter (optional)
- Black or navy trainers or plimsolls.

Children will need a named PE bag to bring their PE kit to school in.

No jewellery should be worn to school (simple stud earrings can be worn but children must be able to remove them by themselves for PE).

No severe hair styles, including patterns or colours.

Long hair must be tied back for safety reasons.

No make-up, including nail varnish and false nails.

In bad weather, boots may be worn to and from school, but shoes are to be brought for indoor wear.
