- Support the school Behaviour Blueprint.
- Attend any parents consultations, reviews, assemblies or events which involve your child.

- Inform the school of any problems that may affect your child's learning or behaviour.

- Be respectful at all times, including towards staff, and adhering to school policies, rules and regulations.

- Let an adult know if there is a problem or you need help.
- Be prepared for learning (arrive on time, with the right equipment and a positive attitude)
