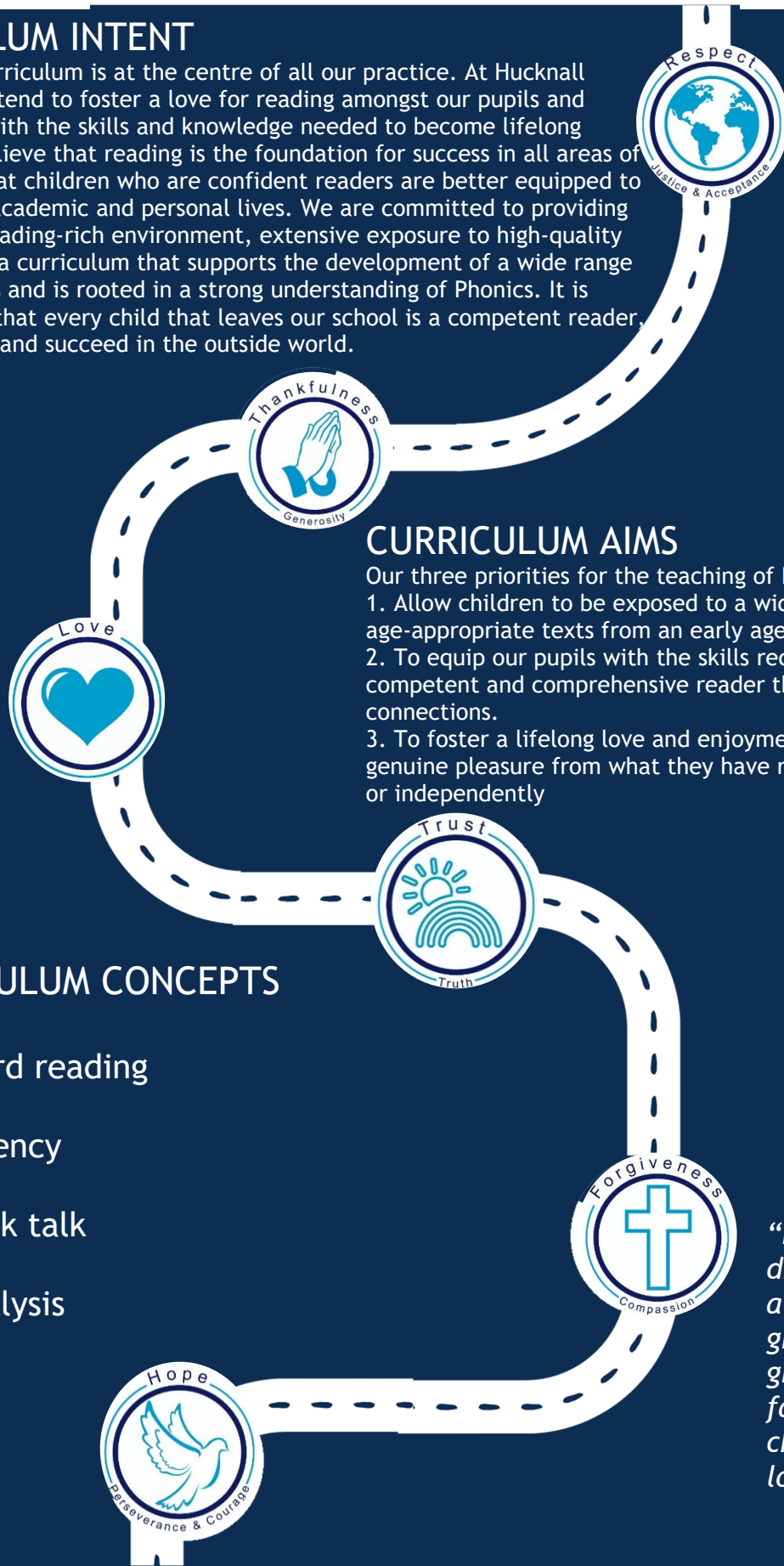




READING INTENT
