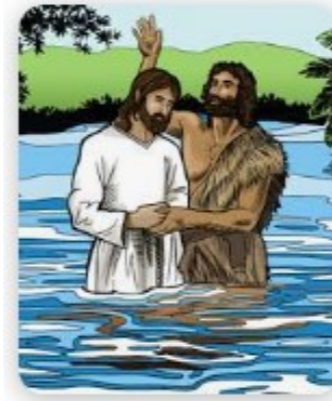

Spelling	Definition/Sentence
Holy spirit	The Holy Spirit is often symbolised as a dove, this is due to the story of Jesus being told.
Baptism	A ceremony that symbolises a commitment to living a life as a Christian.
The Grace	God's unconditional love for everyone, whether or not they have behaved as he wants them to.
The Trinity	The Trinity refers to the idea that God is one, but can be experienced in three different Persons
