Muslim	A follower of the religion of Islam.
Church	A Christian place of worship.

Sacred	Connected to God.
Font	A large stone bowl containing holy water.
Alter	A table where bread and wine are blessed in a church.
Pulpit	Where the priest delivers sermons in Church.
Stained Glass Windows	Colourful windows that often show bible stories.
Qur'an	The Islamic holy book.
Dome	Many mosques have the dome shape to remind them that the universe belongs to God.
Mihrab	A small alcove in a mosque, used for prayer that points toward Mecca.
Imam	The prayer leader in a mosque.
