

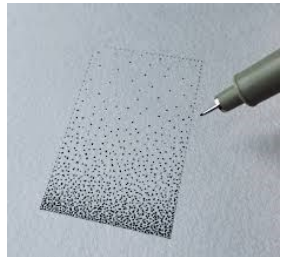

Key vocabulary and information	
Pop Art	Art based on popular things of the time such as everyday objects and adverts.
Roy Lichtenstein	Born in America in 1923 Famous pop artist
Organic shapes	Naturally irregular and imperfect shapes. These shapes look natural and usually have curves.
Stippling	To make small dots that produce an even or softly graded shadow.
Typography	The art of arranging letters and text in a way that makes them clear and appealing to the reader.
Proportion	How the size, height and width of letters relate to each other.
